Father Todd will be offering drive-thru Confessions on Sundays from 9-11 am in the church parking lot. He will remain in his car and you will approach in yours from the opposite direction so that the driver's windows line up.

In addition to their normal items, they are especially in need of food for children's breakfasts such as, cereal, granola bars, pudding etc. Please bring food items to church at any of the times the church is open.
