

Hard to Believe—Lent Starts in Two Weeks!

During Lent, we are asked to devote ourselves to seeking the Lord in prayer and reading Scripture, to service by giving alms, and to sacrifice self-control through fasting. Lent lasts for 40 days from Ash Wednesday to the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, which this year falls on April 14, 2022. It is a reminder of Christ's 40 days of temptation and fasting in the desert, and of Israel's 40 years of wandering in the desert. This penitential season of fasting, alms-giving, and special prayer is like a spiritual cleansing and renewal to draw closer to God.
