

If you would have asked me on the morning of my confirmation what the chances were of the Holy Spirit getting into my heart, I would have told you they were about the same as getting water from a stone.

From the Office of Archbishop Jerome E. Listecki

After careful consideration, Archbishop Jerome E. Listecki has granted dispensation for March 17, 2023 which lifts the obligation of abstinence from meat this Friday March 17th - only, so Catholics in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee can celebrate St. Patrick's Day.

"A feast day in the Church means what it says - it calls for celebratory feasting," Archbishop Listecki said. "However, Catholics who partake in the St. Patrick's Day feast are encouraged to engage in another sacrificial or charitable act that day or give up meat on another day.
