

#### Quick Reference - The Divine Mercy Chaplet

The Divine Mercy Chaplet, a set of prayers that are prayed using rosary beads, often at 3 p.m., the hour of Jesus' death.

Begin with one Our Father, one Hail Mary and the Apostles Creed.

On the Our Father beads of the rosary, recite,

"Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world."

On Hail Mary beads, pray,

"For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and the whole world." Repeat this on all five decades.

At the end: of the five decades: Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world. (Pray three times.)

Optional Closing Prayer: Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion - inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.

Amen.
