





The policeman answered, "No, someone more important than the governor."

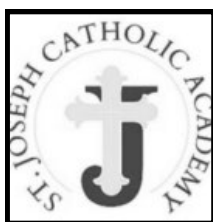
The chief finally asked, "Is it the President?"

The policeman answered, "No, someone even more important than the President."

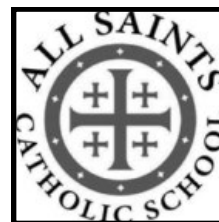
This made the chief very angry, and he bellowed, "Now who is more important than the President?!"
