





What Every Catholic Should Know



THE HOLY EUCHARIST

- 1. The bread and wine of the Eucharist becomes the true transubstantiated body and blood of Christ. It is not a mere symbol
- 2. The Eucharist is the body, bold, soul, and divinity of Christ Jesus
- 3. The reception of Holy Communion is the center of Catholic Faith
- 4. Communion is by definition to be in union with God and with His Church, to be one in faith.
- 5. To receive Communion, a perso must be a practicing Catholic in the state of Grace.
- 6. Only an ordained Catholic priest, in the person of Jesus Christ, the High Priest an transform bread and wine into the body and blood of Christ.


