



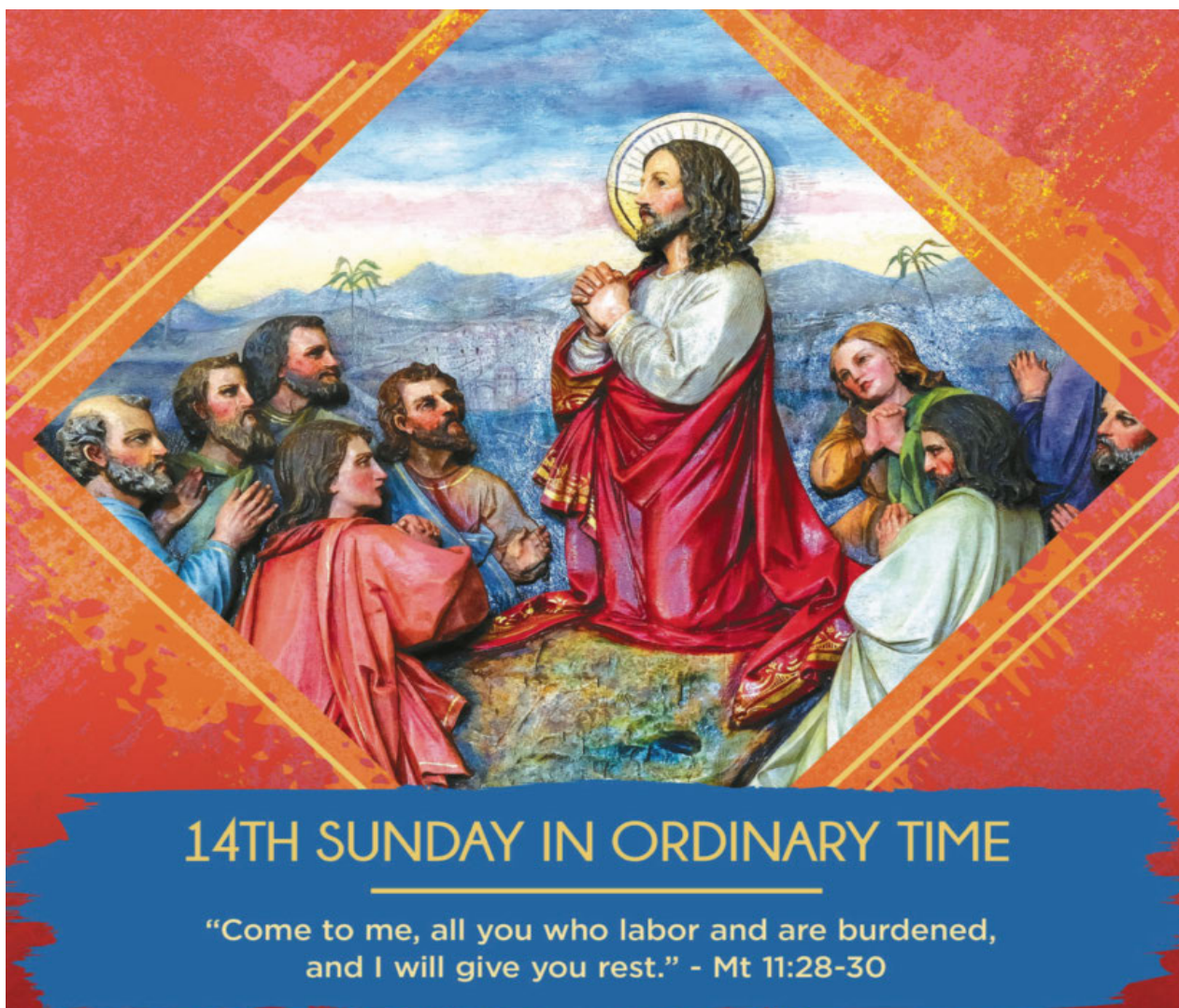

What Every Catholic Should Know



THE HOLY EUCHARIST

1. The bread and wine of the Eucharist becomes the true transubstantiated body and blood of Christ. It is not a mere symbol
2. The Eucharist is the body, bold, soul, and divinity of Christ Jesus
3. The reception of Holy Communion is the center of Catholic Faith
4. Communion is by definition to be in union with God and with His Church, to be one in faith.
5. To receive Communion, a perso must be a practicing Catholic in the state of Grace.
6. Only an ordained Catholic priest, in the person of Jesus Christ, the High Priest an transform bread and wine into the body and blood of Christ.

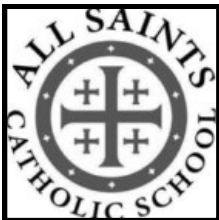
