Father Patrick Peyton, was a devoted priest spreading devotion to our Queen of Heaven and a champion of family prayer, especially the Rosary. He used radio, television, and film in addition to inspiring 540 Rosary Rallies worldwide. Father Patrick is also the person who coined the phrase "The family that prays together stays together". One of his films depicts the Assumption of Mary and the following story.

After Jesus died Mary lived with John. One day she told John "My time has come call all the apostles". Thomas was a four-day journey away. When he arrived, he told Peter that he wanted to see Mother Mary one last time. Peter expressed to Thomas that her body had likely started to decay. Thomas insisted, so together they moved the stone slab and when they entered her tomb they were overwhelmed by the sweet smell of beautiful flowers. However, Mary was gone. So, Peter exclaimed "our Lord has taken His Masterpiece home to Himself"!

The Solemnity of Mary's Assumption is a Holy Day of Obligation. Mass will be celebrated here at St. Anthony's on Tuesday August 15th at 5:00 pm.
