



Getting to Know the Saints



Many years ago (I believe it was more than 25), a very nice older couple from our parish gave me a 688-page book entitled *The 33 Doctors of the Church* to thank me for a formation class that I had organized and facilitated. At the time, I knew very little about any of the Saints and had no idea how one became a Doctor of the Church. I thanked them and promptly put the book on my bookshelf where it sat unopened for many years. From time to time, feeling guilty, I would pick it up and read a few pages and then leave it next to my chair with great intentions. Eventually, likely during a clean-up event in preparation for company, it would make its way back to the bookshelf where it would sit untouched for another few years.

Then a funny thing happened that I have noticed over and over again in the spiritual life. I started hearing messages from a variety of sources about the importance of knowing about and learning from the Saints. Homilies, Catholic literature, CD talks, EWTN, etc. Everyone seemed to be talking about the importance of knowing the Saints. Since this was the only book I owned about the Saints, several years ago I pulled the book down off the shelf one more time and dug in. I've made my way up to Doctor number 30, St. Lawrence of Brindisi.

For those who may be unfamiliar with the term, a Doctor of the Church is a title given by the Catholic Church to Saints recognized as having made a significant contribution to theology or doctrine through their research, study, or writings. They're kind of super Saints. These are amazing men (and now four women) who have had major impacts on the Church as we know it today. Over the coming months, I will use this space to share with you an overview of these highly influential people. By the way, since the book was written, recent Popes have declared three additional Saints to be Doctors, bringing the current total to 36.

Next "Getting to Know the Saints", St. Athanasius, born in 297 and known as The Father of Orthodoxy.




