



All About Our Church: The Nave

In the last, "All About Our Church" article, we learned that the Narthex is the place we enter the church and prepare ourselves before coming into our Lord's Presence.

That place we arrive in our Lord's Presence is called the Nave, where everyone gathers for Mass!

The pews are all facing the sanctuary (which we will learn about next time!), focusing on the same thing- Jesus in the Tabernacle.

The word "nave", in its Latin meaning, translates to "ship".

Heaven is our true home, and Jesus founded the Catholic Church to be our ship to guide us safely to heaven.

The Mass is the highest form of prayer on earth!

At Mass, we receive heavenly food for our journey towards heaven: The Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus truly present in Holy Communion.


