All About Our Church

In our last two articles we learned about the Narthex, the place where we enter the church and the Nave, where everyone gathers for Mass.

In this article we will learn about the Sanctuary, the area raised in front of the church where the altar, the ambo, the celebrant's chair and, in our church, the tabernacle is found.

Separated from the Nave, this is the place reminiscent of the Holy of the Holies, that is, the inner sanctuary of the temple described in the Old Testament.

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal defines the sanctuary as "the place where the altar stands, where the word of God is proclaimed, and where the priest, the deacon and other ministers exercise their offices."

The sanctuary is elevated above the nave floor serving to enhance the view of the laity and to exemplify that it is a special, and most sacred place.
