



We all like to think we are virtuous; however, many of us can't name more than a few of them. In the Catholic Church, there are three very distinct categories of virtues which we all should be praying to have more of: Cardinal Virtues, Theological Virtues, and Capital Virtues.

#### **The Cardinal Virtues**

The Cardinal Virtues are four moral virtues that are the foundation for the others. Cardinal comes from the Latin "cardo", which means "hinge." The Cardinal Virtues can all be acquired through practice, and by observing others who are older and wiser than you are. All other virtues hinge on the four Cardinal V irtues of Prudence, Justice, Fortitude and Temperance.

#### First Reading:

Your light has come, the glory of the Lord shines upon you. (Is 60:1)

#### Psalm:

#### Second Reading:

It was not made known to people in other generations as it has now been revealed to his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit: that the Gentiles are coheirs, members of the same body and copartners in the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel. (Eph 3:5-6)

#### Gospel:

"Where is the newborn king of the Jews? We saw his star at its rising and have come to do him homage." (Mt 2:2)

By using a great big star in the sky, God lead the Wise Men to the manger where they found Christ our newborn king. Odds are that they would not have found the manger without this bright and shining star.

Unlike the wise men, there are no big stars in the sky leading us to where we need to go. We struggle sometimes trying to figure out where God is leading us. We may seek to use our gifts wisely, but in what manner and to what end is not always clear.

This is where prayer can make an enormous difference. If we seek to cultivate a prayer life where we are mindful of the presence of God throughout our day, then the call is easier to discern. We can achieve this by intentionally offering to God in the morning the entirety of our day to come: all of our actions, all of our time, and all our of decisions. In the evening, we can examine our day and reflect on when we responded well to Christ's call and

evening, we can examine our day and reflect on when we responded well to Christ's call and when we fell short. Then we resolve to begin again tomorrow, inviting Christ to be with us every step of the way.

God may not offer a star in the sky to lead us, but if we invite Him through prayer, on our journey each day, the path will be much clearer.
